how we perform a puja



First we clean up. We can't invite any guest into a messy house!





We spread a clean cloth on a small table, so Ganesha and Lakshmi will know where to sit when we invite them.





We place a small pot of water, called a *Kalash*, on the cloth. The pot represents Mother Earth.





Into this *Kalash* we place some rice grains, a small coin, a flower and 5 leaves. The rice and the coin represent the food and the wealth Mother Earth gives us. The flower and the leaves represent the beautiful objects Mother Earth gives us.





Now we place a plate, or *Thali*, in front of the *Kalash*. The *Thali* represents our home. On this *Thali*, we place:

- 1. a diya
- 2. a small container of rice (akshat)
- 3. a small container of water, with a small spoon
- 4. a small container of haldi and kumkum
- 5. 2 sticks of incense (agarbathi)
- 6. a bell
- 7. a long, flat spoon with camphor
